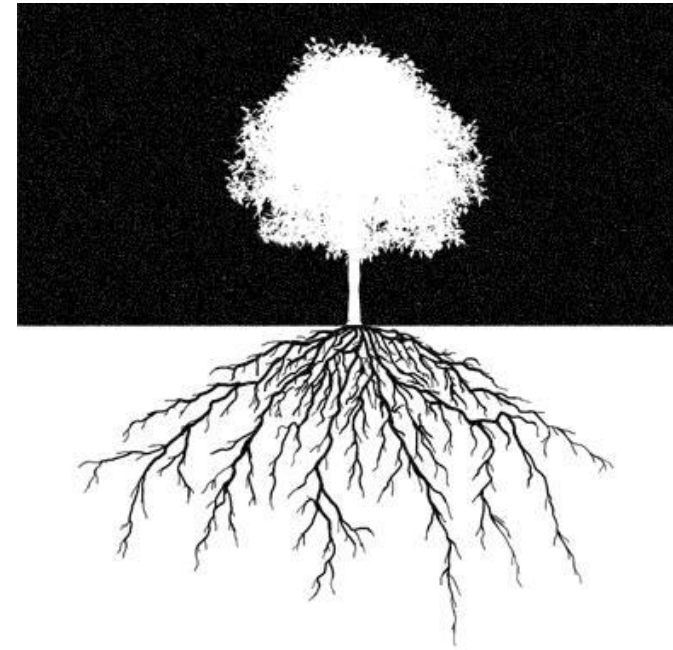

## The New City Catechism

**Re-Cap question 17:** What is idolatry?
