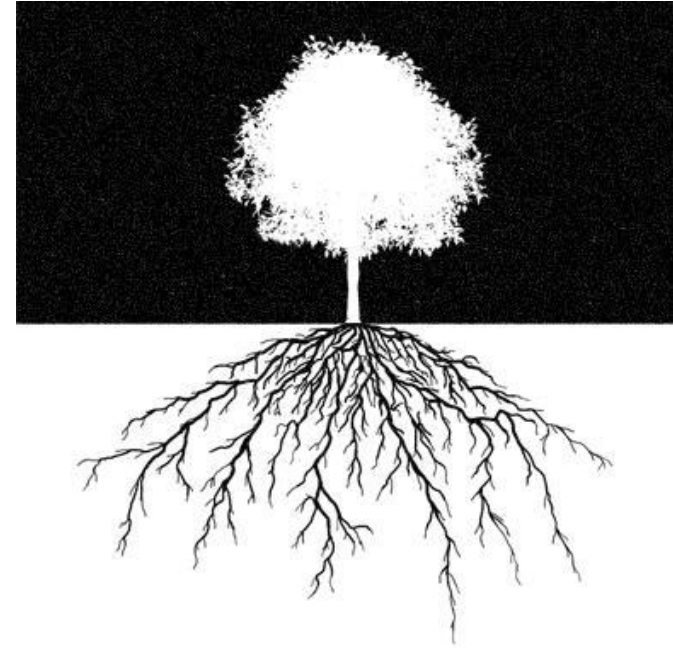

Heidelberg Catechism, Week 8

Question 25: Since there is only one God [1], why do you speak of three persons, Father, Son and Holy Spirit?

A. Because God has so revealed Himself in His Word[2] that these three distinct persons are the one, true, eternal God.
