Proposed By Law Amendment

The leadership responsibilities given to ministers (on committees, in service, and with church vision/direction) require ministers to be members of the church. Therefore, when a minister is called to serve this body, they must commit to the membership of this church. --Acceptance of the calling shall act as their petition for membership. The church's final vote to confirm the call will act as the church's affirmation of the minister's membership. -- Consideration will be given to student ministers who are required to retain membership at a home church, but membership requirements will be waived only with the church's approval.
